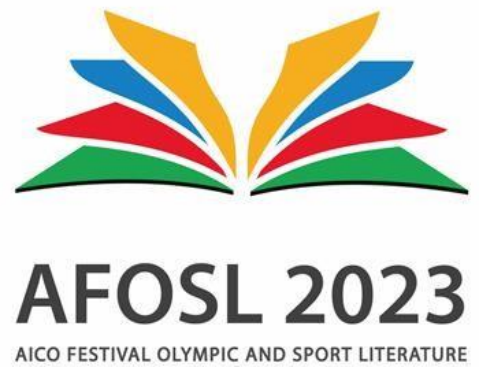


AFOSL 2023 :

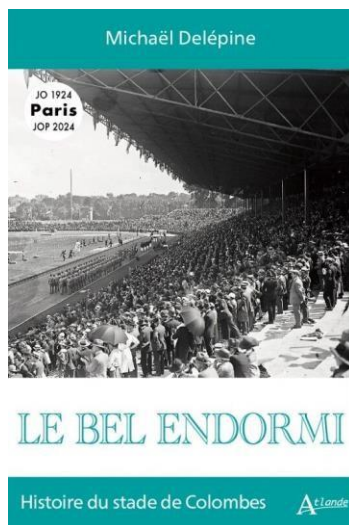


INTERNATIONAL OLYMPISM DAY DEDICATED TO PARISIAN SCHOOLCHILDREN

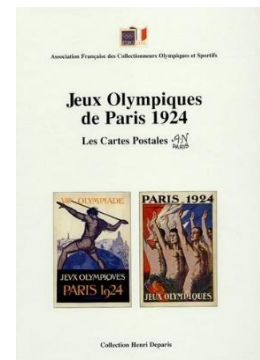
