FESTIVAL OF OLYMPIC AND SPORTS LITERATURE

REGULATIONS

Article 1. Objectives and Organization

In line with the spirit of AICO, the exhibition is open to all sport and Olympic literature topics, and will take place from 22 to 25 June, during the World Olympic Collectors' Fair, PARIS 2023. Entries will also be displayed online at <https://www.aicolympic.org/afosl>.

The goal of this exhibition is to promote the Olympic spirit, through all types of literature.

The event is organized by AICO through the Organizing Committee, which has the responsibility of running the exhibition and supervising it. The members of the Organizing Committee will be chosen by the Executive Board of AICO.

Article 2. Structure of the Exhibition

The exhibition will be organized into the following competitive classes:

- 2.1 Books, specialized and general catalogues, special studies, newsletters and other publications with a focus on sports and the Olympic Games;
- 2.2 Periodicals and magazines;
- 2.3 Current official websites of the associations and of the individual members;

2.4 Articles by members.

Article 3. Requirements for Participation

All classes of competition are open to all literature published by AICO member associations, or their members. Exhibits must be devoted to the Olympic Games, the Olympic Movement, or to any sport recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

In Classes 2.1 and 2.3, there is no limit on when the entry must have been published.

In Class 2.2, magazines and periodicals must have been published no earlier than January 2021.

In Class 2.4, articles must have been published no earlier than January 2021. There are no exhibitor frame fees.

Article 4. Terms for Applications

Applications for participation must be completed using the form provided on the website <https://www.aicolympic.org/afosl> .

Applications will be accepted from 15 April to 15 May 2023.

An applicant's membership in an AICO member association will be verified by the Organizing Committee. If not confirmed, the application will be rejected ex officio.

Article 5. Commitments of the Exhibitor

By signing the application form, the applicant declares to have read and fully accepted all Regulations for AFOSL 2023.

The applicant can mail their literature entries to the Organizing Committee located in Paris, to the follow address :

or hand deliver to the exhibition no later than 22 June.

The applicant also authorizes AICO and the IOC to publish scans of the exhibit online and to display the exhibits during the WOCF Paris 2023 for the

duration of the event. The applicant may also indicate permission for the exhibit to remain at the AICO library following completion of the exhibition. The exhibitor's signature also confirms acceptance of the privacy regulations stated in Article 11.

Incomplete applications, or those that do not meet these requirements shall not be considered.

The applicant may send a digital copy of the most significant pages of the book or magazine by e-mail through the services for transferring large files (e.g. We Transfer, JumboMail, Dropbox, cloud), to the email afosl@aicolympic.org.

The applicant who participates in Class 2.4 for Articles, must submit the entry by email to afosl@aicolympic.org

Article 6. Evaluation of the Exhibits

The competitive section of AFOSL 2023 (Classes 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3) will be judged by the vote of visitors to WOCF PARIS 2023, through the ballots handed out at the exhibition. Winners of each class will receive a special prize. The most popular literature exhibit will receive a grand prize. A further prize will be given to all voters through a drawing lottery

Entries in Class 2.4 for Articles will be judged by Organizing Committee members. All articles will be presented on the AFOSL website.

Article 7. Presentation of Results

The results of the exhibition will be announced in a ceremony during the gala dinner of the WOCF PARIS 2023. The ceremony will be recorded and available on the AFOSL 2023 website.

Article 8. Jury Decisions

The decisions of the Organizing Committee and the evaluations of the public vote are final and binding.

Article 9. Communications with Exhibitors

Communication with exhibitors will take place exclusively through the website www.aicolympic.org or directly via e-mail.

Article 10. Amendments to the Regulations and cases not covered

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the aforementioned rules, promptly informing all exhibitors. Cases not covered by these regulations will be decided by the Organizing Committee.

Article 11. Data protection and Privacy

The data provided by exhibitors will be used for the organization and evaluation of the exhibition and can be stored and transmitted both in electronic and paper format.

The personal data of exhibitors will be processed in accordance with the European law on the use of personal data. Responsible for their treatment is the President of the Organizing Committee.
